

SECTION 4-3-14 REGULATION OF UNIFORM HOUSE NUMBERING

The purpose of this section is to provide for the regulation and coordination of the numbering of all buildings and names of public streets and roads within the Village of Wild Rose and to compel the owners or occupants to maintain numbers assigned and provided by the Village of Wild Rose.

- (a) All owners or occupants of buildings within the Village of Wild Rose shall affix his/her number designated by the Village of Wild Rose Board of Trustees pursuant to this ordinance, to his/her property. Only those numbers signs approved by the Wild Rose Board of Trustees shall be used as the official address number of the property.
- (b) The Village of Wild Rose shall provide at no initial cost to the property owner, a sign and affix it to the property in an area of the property designated by the board to best facilitate the identification of the property. All signs shall be placed perpendicular to the roadway so it is easily visible. Any sign that is damaged or stolen through no fault of the property owner shall be replaced by the village. Property owners with damaged or stolen signs shall notify the Village Clerk no later than then next business day after noticing such damage.
- (c) It shall be the responsibility of the property owner to properly maintain the sign and keep it free from damage, obstruction and other conditions that may prevent the property from being easily identified from the street.
- (d) The Village Board shall have the sole responsibilities of naming and maintain all signs to designated streets within the village limits.
- (e) Any property owner may petition for a change of sign placement to the Village Clerk/Treasurer in writing and explain in detail the reason for the requested change. The Clerk shall then forward the request to the Chief of Police and Head of Village Maintenance, who shall then make a recommendation in writing to the Village Board. All decisions of the Board shall be final.
- (f) It shall be unlawful and punishable for any owner or occupant of a building within the village not to have affixed his/her designated number to the property as provided for in Section 2(a) and (b) of this ordinance. Any person found to be in violation of Section 2(a)(c), upon conviction shall be guilty of violating the ordinance and shall be punished by a fine in accordance to section 1-1-8 of the Village of Wild Rose Ordinances.
